There is more time to register, but there are a limited number of tests; only 7 spots are available at this time. Please contact Mrs. Smith ASAP if you are interested.

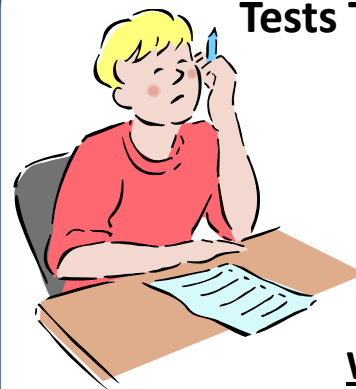

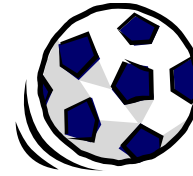
