These students may be dismissed at 2:30 on Tues. and Thur. for the rest of this year. If the student is not picked up, they will be put in a study hall.

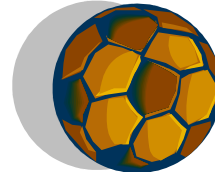
