The group will meet in the library during lunchtime. The group will meet one or two times a week beginning the week of October 19th.

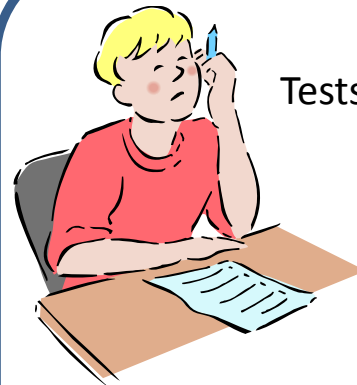

Redeemer: Take Brown Rd. west to Stapley and turn left. Take Stapley Rd. north. The school will be on your left BEFORE you get to University

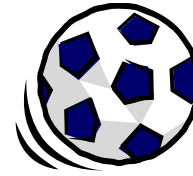
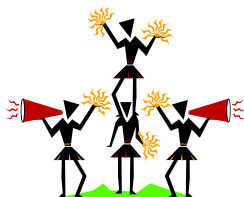
Transportation will be provided to the game. Students may be picked up from the game after it is over.

Transportation to the Games: When the school provides transportation to games via the school's bus or carpools, students are expected to travel with the team. Students are not allowed to transport themselves or other students to athletic contests. Please understand that this is for the safety of the students. See page 35 of the Parent/Student Handbook.

Also, if you are picking your child up at the school following the return from a game, please be at the school no later than the time posted in the Sports Extra. Do not ask students to call when the bus arrives. The bus is almost never later than the posted time and is almost always early. School staff may not leave until all students have been picked up. Please be kind to our staff and be prompt to pick up your child
